### STUDY ABROAD AT STCLARE'S, OXFORD

Our Liberal Arts programme enables visiting undergraduates (or students on a 'gap year') to enjoy a comprehensive study abroad experience while earning academic credits. Students complete 5 academic courses: 4 seminar courses and 1 tutorial class. All classes are small: seminars are typically 2-8 students and capped at 12; tutorials have 1-2 students.

Our classes are based on active student participation: personal responses to readings, presentations and debate. St. Clare's students take responsibility for their learning, benefit from the expertise, support and encouragement of our instructors and work closely with their peers. Assessment is based on the quality of your writing, research and contributions to class. Most seminar courses, and all tutorials, involve **independent study**: our instructors are mentors who help you develop your writing, research and presentational skills.

Study abroad means **studying outside the traditional classroom**- taking advantage of the academic and cultural resources of Oxford,
London and beyond. We run field trips

to the Imperial War Museum, Freud

Museum, Globe Theatre or the British Library in London; our students visit the Mini car plant, the Pitt-Rivers anthropological collections, hear a concert at the Holywell Music Room (the oldest in Europe) and visit the colleges that generations of writers have made famous from Oscar Wilde to J.R.R. Tolkien – all here in Oxford.

We offer a wide range of subjects within the following disciplines:

### EXPLORING OXFORD, THE U.K. AND EUROPE

We'll help you make Oxford your home. Our full activities programme will introduce you to this vibrant, safe and student-friendly city: visit the historic colleges and museums, take walks to country pubs and go boating in a 'punt' to explore the riverside. We run a comprehensive programme of weekday and weekend excursions to help you explore the iconic sites in Britain.
