


# UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME

## GAIN MORE FROM YOUR STUDY EXPERIENCE

Our Undergraduate programme enables visiting students (or those on a 'gap year') to enjoy a comprehensive study abroad experience while earning academic credits. You will complete 5 academic courses. This includes 4 seminar courses and 1 tutorial class. All classes are small. Seminars typically have between 2-8 students. Tutorials provide more dedicated support and consist of up to 2 students.

Our classes encourage engagement, this includes personal responses to readings, presentations and debate. You will benefit from the expertise, support and encouragement of our tutors and work closely with your peers. Assessment is based on the quality of your writing, research and contributions to class. Our seminars and tutorials, mostly involve independent **study**. You will also be allocated a mentor who will help you to develop your writing, research and presentational skills.

# Study abroad means **studying outside the traditional classroom**

– taking advantage of the academic and cultural resources of Oxford, London and beyond. We run field trips to the Imperial War Museum, Freud Museum, Globe Theatre or the British Library in London. You can visit the Mini car plant, the Pitt-Rivers Museum, hear a concert at the Holywell Music Room (the oldest in Europe) or visit the colleges that famous writers including Oscar Wilde and J.R.R. Tolkien have made famous – all here in Oxford.
