

Deposit and fees

The registration fee is £100 for all courses.

Our enrolment deposit is £2,500 for our IB Diploma.

The Pre-IB enrolment deposit depends on your entry point in September (£2,500), January (£1,500) or April (£500).

Annual course fees

Our annual **boarding fees are £42,626** and **day fees are £20,480.** The fees include travel and fees insurance.
