INTRODUCTION

FROM THE CAREERS AND HIGHER EDUCATION TEAM



Choosing a university is a huge decision and the St Clare's University Foundation Programme is specifically designed to help students develop relevant skills for higher education and also be able to produce extremely competitive university applications for both the UK and overseas.

For well over a decade, we have had students join us from a broad range of countries – from Mexico to France, from the Netherlands to China – the list is endless and ever-growing!

Depending on where the student comes from, after completing their high school studies, students may not be eligible for direct entry to university and thus a foundation programme is essential. For other students, even if they are able to apply directly to universities, using the high school qualifications from their home countries, the advantage of graduating from our University Foundation Programme results in applications which are even more competitive. Moreover, students will have acquired skills to be more prepared for the academic rigour of their subsequent university journeys. This booklet lists the progression agreements we currently have in place. Our definition of a progression agreement (or what some universities call an "admissions agreement") is: a student who is on

our University Foundation Programme is 100% guaranteed to receive a conditional offer from the university should the student choose to apply to that institution. We are extremely proud of our progression agreements – the fact that higher education providers are prepared to unequivocally award an offer to any St Clare's foundation student highlights the trust institutions have in the rigour and quality of the programme we have designed.

I should also state that whilst we have progression agreements in place, with an exciting range of excellent institutions, we by no means push students towards only choosing these places. We advise and encourage students to look more holistically at what is available. My personal advice is in fact to choose a range (progression and non-progression destinations) and thus diversify risk – select some progression agreement options but also don't limit yourself to only these institutions. From supporting students as a Careers and Higher Education Adviser, I have truly noticed how reassuring it is for students to know that they are guaranteed to receive some offers simply by undertaking the St Clare's University Foundation Programme. This then allows students to put greater focus on their academic studies and also be even more adventurous with the university applications they submit.

OF ACCEPTANCE AND RECOGNITION

In addition to progression agreements, some institutions have also expressed an interest in signing certificates of acceptance and recognition. This is not the same as a progression agreement which guarantees a conditional offer.

However, having such certificates in place is a demonstration from the institution that they have formally accessed our University Foundation Programme. We have noticed that whilst these certificates do not guarantee offers, they do streamline the application process and can lead to successful application outcomes.

Whether we have a progression agreement or certification, students graduate from the St Clare's University Foundation Programme to join a broad range of excellent institutions from around the world. They are not limited to only selecting institutions where we have formalised relationships in place.
